

We'll be making macramé bud vases—like a plant hanger, but designed to hold a beautiful upcycled glass vessel, with a mind to bring some of May's fresh blooms inside. They hang best against a wall (on a screw, hook, or nail) so no need to go wrangling a drill to your ceiling.

I'll teach you all of the knots and skills from a beginner level (though you knotters with some experience are welcome to come and advance your technique). It'll be a space that's fun, casual, creative, and welcoming to all.

The workshop will start at 11 am and finish at 1 pm. Some light refreshments—and all materials, naturally—will be provided as part of your ticket price. We'll be using a combo of organic/recycled cotton fibre and supremely gorgeous upcycled glassware.
